## NOTES FOR GUIDANCE

There are notes throughout the form on each relevant section and there are more detailed instructions listed below:

### A. Ownership of land, area of holding and grassland & rough grazing & common land

#### Grassland-Boxes G1&G2:

- **Include** land actively farmed for grazing, conserved forage for livestock feed or herbage.

#### Rough grazing-Box G5:

- **Include** - mountain, heath, moor, down or other rough land used for grazing where you have sole grazing rights;
- **Exclude** - common grazing, woodland grazing and marshland.

#### Industrial crops on set-aside - Box GC2

- **Include** winter and spring industrial oilseed rape, industrial linseed and other industrial crops **grown on set-aside**.

#### Woodland - Box G14

- **Include** - woodland used for commercial or amenity purposes, trees planted under a farm woodland scheme, woodland used for grazing;
- **Exclude** - orchards and set-aside land.

#### Other land - Box G17:

- **Include** land converted to recreational use or for non-agricultural use, paths, roads, yards, buildings, etc.

### C. Cattle at 1st June 2005

## Glossary of terms

### Casual or regular:

**Casual** labour refers to people employed for a fixed part or parts of the year which covers **1st June 2005**. Typically this period would not be in excess of 20 weeks. Such labour are deemed to be casual, irrespective of the number of hours worked. Employees working longer than a 20-week period should be viewed as **regular** labour and classed as either **full-time** or **part-time** (See below).

### Full time or part time

This status is determined by the average number of hours worked per week. If this figure is **39 hours or more** it is deemed to be **full-time**; if it is **less than 39 hours** then the worker is deemed to be **part-time**.

## SECTION I - (QUESTION NUMBERS Q5A TO Q12A)

**Principal farmer:** the person(s) who own(s) the land and who tends it. This also covers people who rent in land for more than a year at a time who, for the purposes of this return, are classed as the principal farmer.

(NB. if **all** the land is let out for a period of less than a year then you should indicate this at question **HC6B** on **Page 3** and therefore the questions on labour need not be completed ).

**Spouse:** any spouses or (non-business) partners of people included above. Note that they should only be included if they work on the holding or assist in the running of the holding.

**Other business partners, directors and their spouses:** any people not already included who have financial and/or legal responsibility for the running of the holding. As above also include any spouses if they work on the holding.
